Under close supervision and tutelage, the student staff shall experience and learn to:

- Develop and implement a campus ministry plan that complements the ISI national strategic plan.
- Establish and build relationships with international students for the purpose of sharing the Gospel with them.
- Develop student leaders and disciple believing international students, preparing them for ministry in their homeland.
- Incorporate volunteers into ministry and coordinate with any local City Mobilizer to develop partnerships with churches and pastors.
- Develop and maintain relationships with university faculty and staff.
- Establish and maintain campus ministry and returnee information reporting systems.
- Finance ministry work by learning the budgeting process as well as learning and implementing proven methods of fundraising to reach a specific funding goal as determined by the supervisor (funding needs vary by location)

Activities may include, but are not limited to:

- o Going through the Exploring ISI modules with their local supervisor as their coach
- o Completing the 100+ Partnership Development manual under tutelage of the supervisor
- o Reading books and watching videos recommended by the supervisor, providing a report upon completion
- Accompanying team members in one-to-one meetings with students and undertaking such meetings themselves under team member oversight once they have received appropriate training.
- Observing and assisting the ISI team in group activities, including Friday night ICF, various parties and functions, Bible Studies, cell groups, short trips, and other creative methods of direct contact with international students.
- Observing and assisting the Area Mobilizer in the screening, education, and matching of Friendship Partners with international students.
- o Attending or completing training in the M-28 ministry model.
- o Attending staff meetings and events as available.
